FIRST READING

Hebrews 9.24–28

A reading from the letter to the Hebrews.

Christ did not enter a sanctuary made by human hands,
a mere copy of the true one, but he entered into heaven
itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our
behalf. Nor was it to offer himself again and again, as
the high priest enters the Holy Place year after year with
blood that is not his own; for then he would have had to
suffer again and again since the foundation of the world.
But as it is, he has appeared once for all at the end of
the age to remove sin by the sacrifice of himself. And
just as it is appointed for mortals to die once, and after
that the judgement, so Christ, having been offered once
to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time,
not to deal with sin, but to save those who are eagerly
waiting for him. This is the Word of the Lord.

GOSPEL

Mark 12.38–44

Hear the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to
Mark. **Glory to you, O Lord.**

Jesus was teaching in the temple, and a large crowd was
listening to him. He said, 'Beware of the scribes, who
like to walk around in long robes, and to be greeted with
respect in the marketplaces, and to have the best seats
in the synagogues and places of honour at banquets!
They devour widows' houses and for the sake of
appearance say long prayers. They will receive the
greater condemnation.' He sat down opposite the
treasury, and watched the crowd putting money into
the treasury. Many rich people put in large sums. A poor
widow came and put in two small copper coins, which
are worth a penny. Then he called his disciples and said
to them, 'Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put in
more than all those who are contributing to the
treasury. For all of them have contributed out of their
abundance; but she out of her poverty has put in
everything she had, all she had to live on.' This is the
Gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you, O Christ.**
