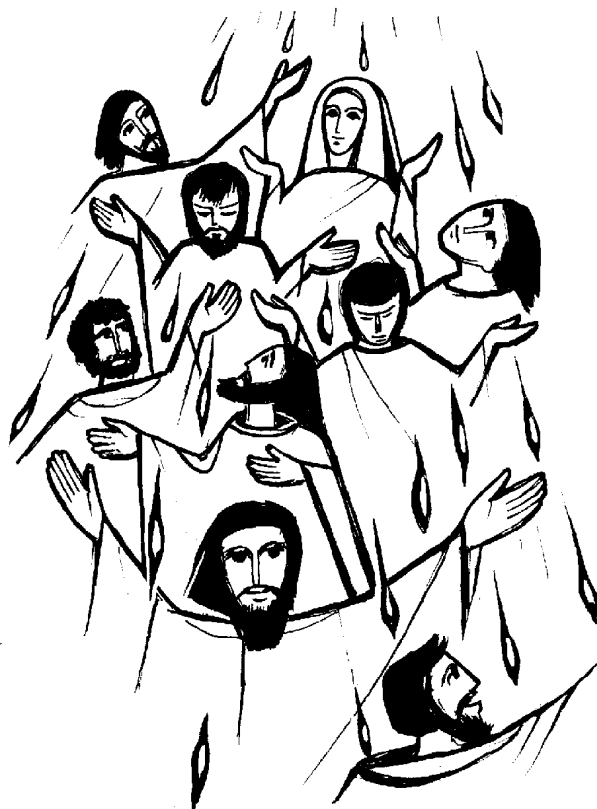

All **It is right to give thanks and praise.**

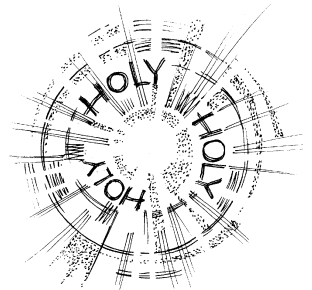
Child's Question:

After they had eaten, he took the cup of wine,
gave thanks, and shared it with his disciples, saying:
*'This is my blood, poured out for you and for many,
for the forgiveness of sins.'*

So Father, with this bread and this cup
we celebrate his love, his death, his risen life.
As you feed us with these gifts, send your Holy Spirit.
and change us more and more
to be like Jesus our Saviour.



Child's Question:

the sun has come up, the night is behind.

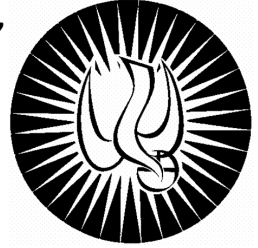
Go down in the city, into the street,
